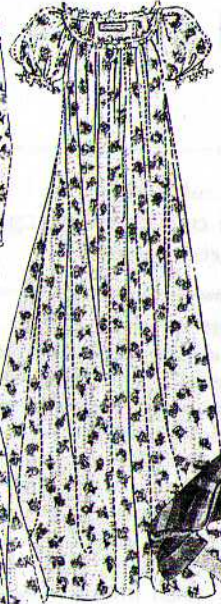

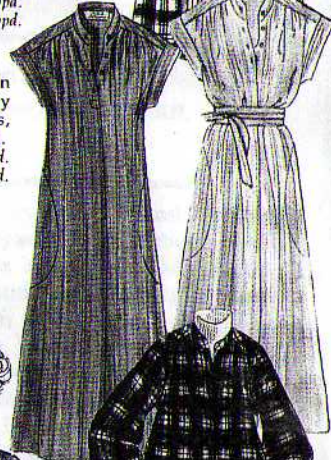

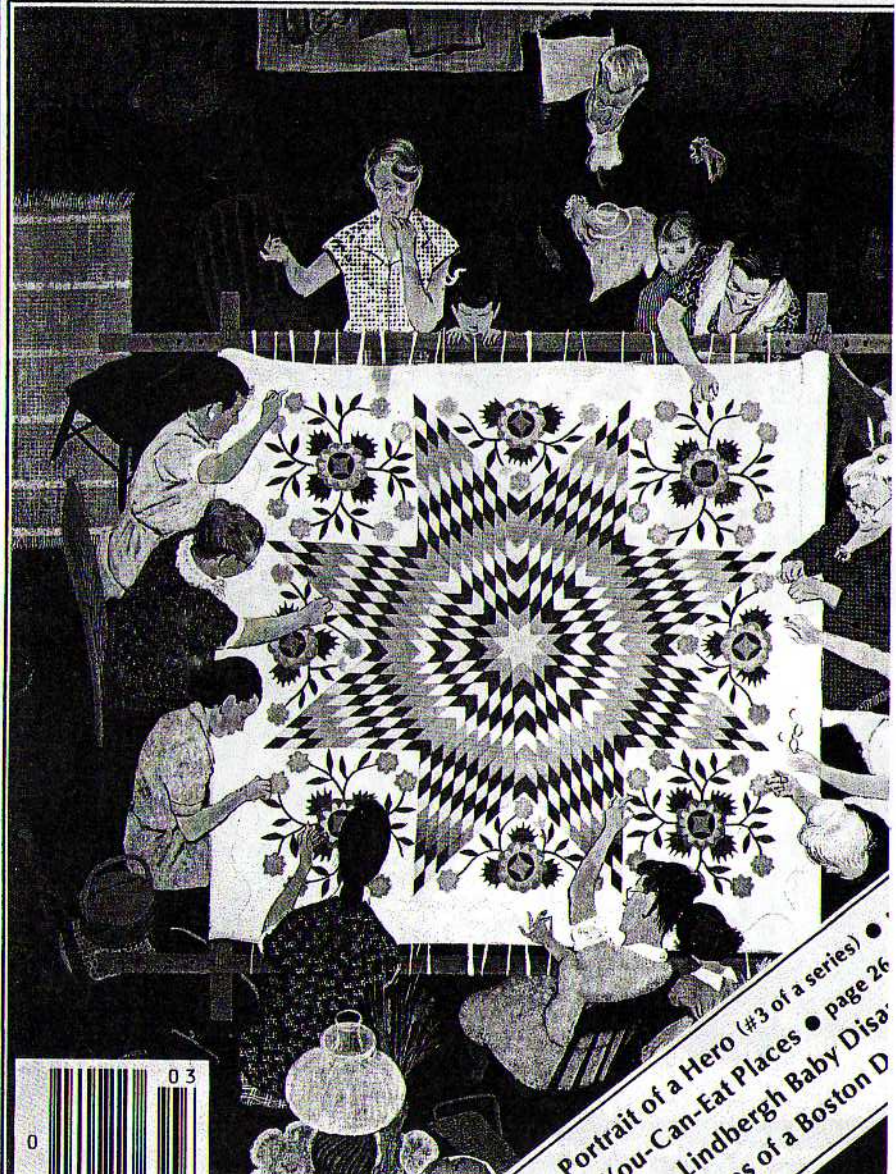

## GAMBLING ON THE FUTURE OF HULL

In 1977, Hull (Massachusetts) voted to permit licensing of a gambling casino in the town. Not everyone, it turns out, thought that was such a great idea ...

□ THE OLD HALL ESTATE, NEAR THE border between the Massachusetts South Shore towns of Cohasset and Hull, has been empty for a long time. The entrance — a cracked asphalt drive in a gap between low fieldstone walls — is marked only by a paper sign tied around a tree trunk: BEWARE OF DOG. A chain slung low across the road keeps cars out, but doesn't hinder pedestrians.

The road leads uphill through a field of knee-high grass, past a stone-faced rectangle that must once have been the swimming pool, up to the rocky hilltop. The "mansion" to the right is a modest-sized Queen Anne brown-shingled house, the paint peeling, the windows boarded with plywood. Across from the mansion stands a Victorian clapboard garage painted an incongruous salmon pink.

The Hall Estate seems little different from hundreds of old summer places in New England, too big and too expensive to pay taxes on or to repair, waiting patiently for the forest or the developer. But there is a difference. Today the Hall

Estate is owned by MGM Grand Hotels, Inc., of Las Vegas. And in about two years, if all goes well for MGM Grand, the twin glass and steel 17-story towers of a \$76-million resort hotel will rise from the rocky hillside, flanked by a glass-enclosed pool, fountains, tennis courts, and a nine-hole golf course cut into elaborately landscaped terraces. But the guests who stay in the \$100-a-day rooms will not be there just for the golf and tennis, or the European-style cuisine, or the Las Vegas-style floor shows. "The Windjammer" will be the first permanent, legal casino in New England.

In 1977 the town of Hull voted on a referendum to permit licensing of a gambling casino within the town. But not everyone in Hull is ready to accept "The Windjammer" as inevitable. There is Hull's "Citizens Against Casino Gambling." And there is the group's founder, Carol Oteri.

In front of a neat, cedar-shingled house was a battered station wagon with
